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ORDINANCE NO. 18 S - 2019

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BANTON PROVINCE OF ROMBLON AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS RELATIVE THERETO.

Be it ordained by the Members of Sangguniang Bayan in its regular session assembled:

Section 1. TITLE - The Ordinance shall be known as Banton Scholarship Program.

Section 2. PURPOSE - The purpose of establishing the scholarship program is to provide a better chance and opportunity to poor but deserving students.

Section 3. RECIPIENTS QUALIFICATIONS - The recipients of the Scholarship program shall have the following qualifications:

- A. Resident and graduate in any secondary institution in the Municipality.
- B. A person of Good Moral Character as certified by the School Principal/Brgy. Captain of his/her residence
- C. Hails from a Family whose combined annual gross income of parents should not be more than;
 1. 50,000.00 for a Family of one (1) dependent
 2. 60,000.00 for a Family of two (2) dependents
 3. 70,000.00 for a Family of three (3) dependents
- D. The applicant shall have no grade below 80% in any subject in the final rating.
- E. Is not enjoying any other scholarship benefit besides the free college education in public schools.

Section 4. BENEFITS - The program's policy to the scholar shall be limited only to a maximum of one thousand five hundred pesos (₱1,500) monthly stipend for ten months yearly for only one (1) course of study and in the maximum of four (4) years.

Section 5. RESPONSIBILITIES OF SCHOLARS.

1. A scholar shall render forty (40) hours of duty without pay before the next school year in the municipality. The work shall be specified by the board.
2. He/She shall serve as a model student for his fellow students from Banton.

Section 6. FORFEITURE OF SCHOLARSHIP GRANT -

1. When he/she waives the privilege/grant.
2. When he/she stops schooling.

3. Upon the commission of any crime in the duration of grant.
4. When he/she has failing grade in any subject
5. When his/her scholastic personal record proved to be inimical to the objective of the program, such as, but not limited to;
 - 5.1 Acts involving moral turpitude.
 - 5.2 Wilful skipping from classes for unjustifiable reasons.
 - 5.3 Engages in vices such as drinking, smoking, using/pushing illegal drugs.
6. Fails to comply with the grantee's responsibilities.

Section 7. BANTON SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM BOARD -

- A. There shall be established a governing board which composition shall be as follows.
 1. Mayor – Chairman
 2. Vice Mayor – Vice Chairman
 3. MSWDO - Secretary
 4. Principal of BNHS and TNHS
 5. Municipal Treasurer
 6. PTA President
 7. SB Committee on Education
 8. SB Committee on Social Services
 9. SB Committee on Appropriation
 10. President of Banton Student Organization in the Romblon State University
- B. Functions of the board shall be;
 1. To propose to the Sanggunian annual budgetary allocation for the operation and maintenance of the scholarship program.
 2. To exercise full supervision and control in the operation and management of the scholarship program.
 3. To formulate policies, rules and regulations not otherwise provided thereof.
 4. Ask Donations or funding support from provincial government or from other government agencies and non-government organization.
 5. Finalize the list of beneficiaries
- C. Secretariat – The MSWDO shall act as secretariat of the program and secretary to the board.
- D. Meeting and Quorum - The members of the board shall meet twice annually or as often as maybe necessary. The majority of the members shall constitute a quorum.

Section 8. NUMBER OF RECIPIENTS – The number of recipients shall be determined each year by the members of the Board depending in the availability of Funds.

Section 9. FUNDING – A sum of not less than three hundred thousand pesos (₱300,000.00) shall be allocated annually beginning in year 2020 onwards.

Section 10. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISION –

1. Once a scholar has graduated and is gainfully employed, he or she shall be obliged to contribute to the scholarship program in an amount not less than five thousand pesos (₱5,000.00). The amount shall be remitted to the Municipal Treasurer's Office but shall serve as trust fund for the Scholarship Program
2. This program shall be availed of only by qualified beneficiaries who will enroll in College within the province.
3. If possible/feasible every barangay shall be given a slot.

Section VII. REPEALING CLAUSE - All municipal Ordinances, Municipal Executive Order or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section VIII. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this ordinance held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section IX. EFFECTIVITY - This ordinance shall take effect immediately 15 days upon approval.

"Be it ordained that copies of this Ordinance be furnished the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Romblon, Romblon for their information, review and appropriate action, the Honorable Mayor, the Barangay Captains and the Municipal Treasurer for their information, reference and implementation."
